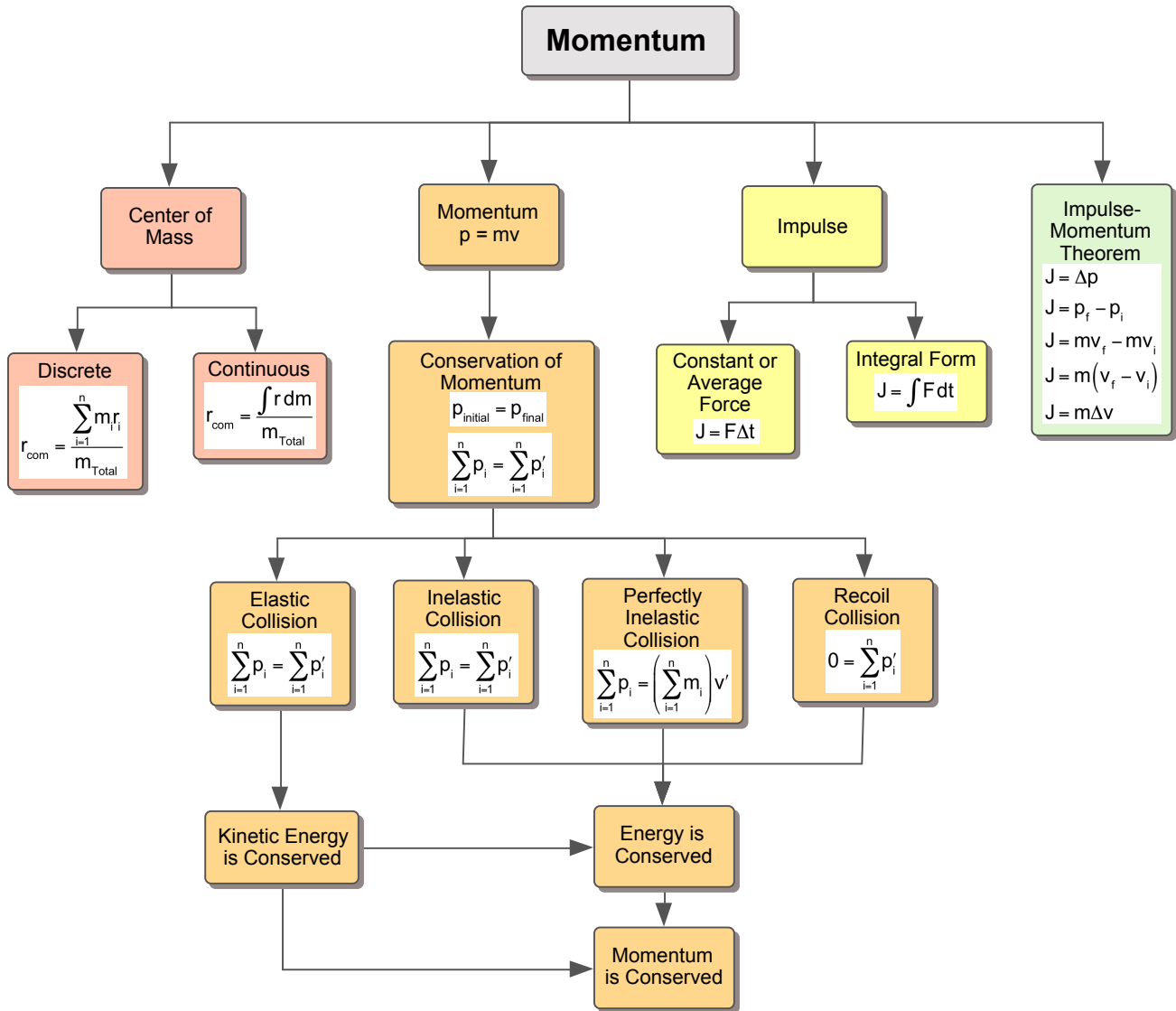
Enduring Understanding - Momentum is transferred when objects interact.

Type of Collision Problems

Step #1

How can the bullet acquire energy (velocity)?

- o given an initial velocity
- o an energy transformation
- o gravitational
- o elastic

Step #2

How might the target and bullet collide?

- o hit and stick
- o hit and bounce
- o hit and pass through

Step #3

What the situations could be encountered after the collision?

- an energy exchange
 - o swing
 - o loop
 - o hill
 - o curved-vertical path
- an energy transformation
 - o slides on a rough surface.
- projectile motion
